Writing	
<input type="checkbox"/> Format book template	Download free templates here . If you want to publish ebooks, I highly recommend starting with certain formatting for ebooks from the beginning. This will save you time later when formatting your book for the various types of ebook readers.
<input type="checkbox"/> Finish your first draft	80% of people say they want to write a book “some day” and very few actually finish it! Be one of the people that takes action and finishes your book. It may take sacrifice and commitment, but it will be worth it.
<input type="checkbox"/> Edit your book	http://www.self-publishing-coach.com/copy-editing-service.html
<input type="checkbox"/> Start an online platform to sell your book	I highly recommend writing an information website or blog for your target audience. Also consider starting a Facebook , Twitter , LinkedIn and/or YouTube account. Why start now? Then, you’ll have a target group of people waiting to buy your book when you publish it. Most authors wait until their book is finished to do any marketing, I encourage you to start now.

<input type="checkbox"/> Have your book cover designed	If you are only publishing your book as an ebook, then a high quality book cover is not required. A few book design tips: http://www.self-publishing-coach.com/book-cover-design.html You can use 99Designs or Crowdspring to find a designer. Simply name your price, post your project



<input type="checkbox"/> Buy ISBN (optional) -	<p>http://www.self-publishing-coach.com/isbn-lookup.html</p> <p>Createspace provides ISBN for free, Kindle doesn't require one and Smashwords provides ISBN for \$9.95</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Obtain a copyright (optional)	<p>http://www.self-publishing-coach.com/obtaining-a-copyright.html</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Decide whether to start a self publishing company, for example a LLC or S-Corp, etc. (optional)	<p>There are pros and cons to each. If starting small, you can file everything as an individual and then form a company later. However, I recommend consulting legal advice if you have further questions.</p>
<i>Publishing – Print Books</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Choose your publishing company.	<p>I recommend Createspace or Lightning Source.</p> <p>I have used Createspace, an Amazon.com company and print on demand publisher. I highly recommend Createspace for many reasons: they have low costs and decent royalties. Plus, using Createspace is one of the easiest, quickest and cost effective ways to get published on Amazon. Sign up for a free account here.</p> <p>Why choose Lightning Source? More control over costs, better royalties for international sales (i.e. Amazon.uk) and better royalties for brick and mortar stores through Ingram database. Read one person's experience with both companies here.</p> <p>**Note: if you'd like to print hard back books, check out Lulu.</p>

Publishing – eBooks	
<input type="checkbox"/> Choose your eBook publishing platform.	I recommend publishing with Kindle, Smashwords and also selling the PDF from your website.
<input type="checkbox"/> Format your book template	<p>Both the Kindle and Smashwords accept Word document files and will convert them for you (.doc). However, they need to be in a certain format.</p> <p>You can read Kindle's simplified guide to formatting and the Smashwords style guide for all the details.</p> <p>I have also created and used a template for Kindle and Smashwords that you can use. You simply copy and paste your text into the template for Kindle and then make a few minor changes for Smashwords. Download the template here: http://kindle.self-publishing-coach.com/</p>

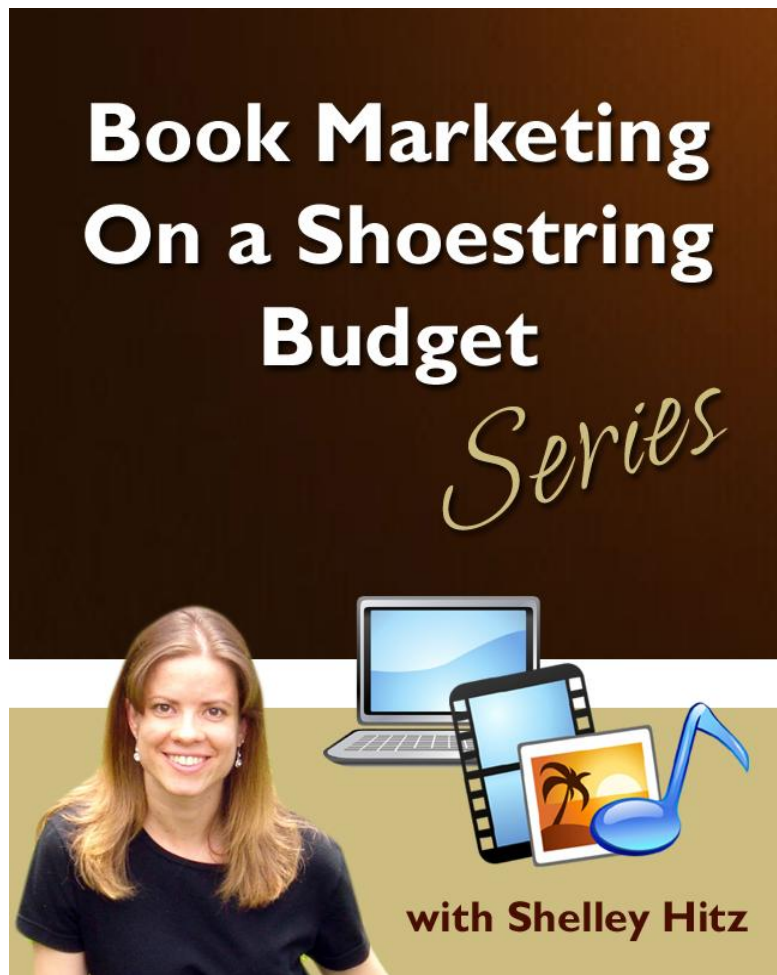
